- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 66.20 RCW 4 to read as follows:
- 5 (1) There shall be a permit known as a day spa permit to allow the to offer or supply without charge, wine or beer by 6 7 individual glass to a customer for consumption on the premises. The 8 customer must be at least twenty-one years of age and may only be 9 offered wine or beer if the services he or she will be receiving will last more than one hour. Wine or beer served or consumed shall be 10 purchased from a Washington state licensed retailer. A customer may 11 12 consume no more than one six ounce glass of wine or one twelve ounce 13 glass of beer per day under this permit. Day spas with a day spa permit may not advertise the service of complimentary wine or beer and 14 15 may not sell wine or beer in any manner. Any employee involved in the service of wine or beer must complete a board-approved limited alcohol 16 17 server training program.
- 18 (2) For the purposes of this section, "day spa" means a business 19 that offers at least three of the following four service categories:
- 20 (a) Hair care;
- 21 (b) Skin care;
- 22 (c) Nail care; and
- 23 (d) Body care, such as massages, wraps, and waxing.
- Day spas must provide separate service areas of the day spa for at least three of the service categories offered.
- 26 (3) The annual fee for this permit is one hundred twenty-five dollars.
- 28 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of this

- 1 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
- 2 June 30, 2014, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and
- 3 void."
- 4 Correct the title.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Adds a null and void clause. The bill is null and void unless funded in the budget.
