1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.65 RCW  
4 to read as follows:

5 (1) Any application for a food fish guide license under RCW  
6 77.65.370 or game fish guide license under RCW 77.65.480 must include:

7 (a) The applicant's driver's license or other government-issued  
8 identification card number and the jurisdiction of issuance;

9 (b) The applicant's unified business identifier number under a  
10 master license issued under RCW 19.02.070;

11 (c) Proof of current certification in first aid and cardiopulmonary  
12 resuscitation;

13 (d) A certificate of insurance demonstrating that the applicant has  
14 commercial liability coverage of at least three hundred thousand  
15 dollars; and

16 (e) If applicable, an original or notarized copy of a valid license  
17 issued by the United States coast guard to the applicant that  
18 authorizes the holder to carry passengers for hire.

19 (2) The requirements of this section related to licensure by the  
20 United States coast guard apply only to applicants intending to carry  
21 passengers for hire with a motorized vessel on federally recognized  
22 navigable waters. The license issued by the United States coast guard  
23 must be valid in the waters where the game fish guide or food fish  
24 guide license applicant will be carrying passengers for hire in a  
25 motorized vessel.

26 (3) The requirements in this section are in addition to the  
27 requirements of RCW 77.65.050.

28 **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.65.480 and 2011 c 339 s 30 are each amended to read  
29 as follows:

1 (1) A taxidermy license allows the holder to practice taxidermy for  
2 commercial purposes, as that term is defined in RCW 77.15.110. The fee  
3 for this license is one hundred eighty dollars. The application fee is  
4 seventy dollars.

5 (2) A fur dealer's license allows the holder to purchase, receive,  
6 or resell raw furs for commercial purposes, as that term is defined in  
7 RCW 77.15.110. The fee for this license is one hundred eighty dollars.  
8 The application fee is seventy dollars.

9 (3) A game fish guide license allows the holder to offer or perform  
10 the services of a game fish guide in the taking of game fish. The fee  
11 for this license is one hundred eighty dollars for a resident and six  
12 hundred dollars for a nonresident. The application fee is seventy  
13 dollars. An application for a game fish guide license must include the  
14 information required in section 1 of this act.

15 (4) A game farm license allows the holder to operate a game farm to  
16 acquire, breed, grow, keep, and sell wildlife under conditions  
17 prescribed by the rules adopted pursuant to this title. The fee for  
18 this license is seventy-two dollars for the first year and forty-eight  
19 dollars for each following year. The application fee is seventy  
20 dollars.

21 (5) A game fish stocking permit allows the holder to release game  
22 fish into the waters of the state as prescribed by rule of the  
23 commission. The fee for this permit is twenty-four dollars. The  
24 application fee is seventy dollars.

25 (6) A fishing or field trial permit allows the holder to promote,  
26 conduct, hold, or sponsor a fishing or field trial contest in  
27 accordance with rules of the commission. The fee for a fishing contest  
28 permit is twenty-four dollars. The fee for a field trial contest  
29 permit is twenty-four dollars. The application fee is seventy dollars.

30 (7)(a) An anadromous game fish buyer's license allows the holder to  
31 purchase or sell steelhead trout and other anadromous game fish  
32 harvested by Indian fishers lawfully exercising fishing rights reserved  
33 by federal statute, treaty, or executive order, under conditions  
34 prescribed by rule of the director. The fee for this license is one  
35 hundred eighty dollars. The application fee is one hundred five  
36 dollars.

37 (b) An anadromous game fish buyer's license is not required for

1 those businesses that buy steelhead trout and other anadromous game  
2 fish from Washington licensed game fish dealers and sell solely at  
3 retail.

4 **Sec. 3.** RCW 77.65.370 and 2009 c 333 s 8 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 (1) A person shall not offer or perform the services of a food fish  
7 guide without a food fish guide license in the taking of food fish for  
8 personal use in freshwater rivers and streams, except that a charter  
9 boat license is required to operate a vessel from which a person may  
10 for a fee fish for food fish in state waters listed in RCW  
11 77.65.150(4)(b).

12 (2) Only an individual at least sixteen years of age may hold a  
13 food fish guide license. No individual may hold more than one food  
14 fish guide license.

15 (3) An application for a food fish guide license must include the  
16 information required in section 1 of this act."

17 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Requires an applicant for a food fish guide or game fish  
guide license to have documentation of commercial insurance (as opposed  
to general insurance) and requires, for applicants intending on  
carrying passengers for hire with motorized boats on navigable waters,  
the applicant to provide proof of licensure from the United States  
coast guard.
