EFFECT: Provides funding to DSHS Economic services for implementing 12 month eligibility in the Working Connections Child Care program related to implementation of E2SHB 2377 (early care and education). Specifies that the Working Connections Child Care program is capped at 30,000 households per month.

Provides funding to DSHS Children and Family services for costs related to 2 percent quality payments and tiered reimbursement rate increases related to implementation of E2SHB 2377 (early care and education).

Provides funding to the Washington Institute of Public Policy to carryout research related to implementation of E2SHB 2377 (early care and education).

Provides funding to the Department of Early Learning to: establish tiered reimbursement rates for child care center providers, implement a substitute pool, establish need based grants, and other activities related to implementation of E2SHB 2377 (early care and education).

Modifies the Education Legacy Trust Account to allow it to be used for expenditures related to the Early Start Act, Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 2377 (Early care and education).

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases Education Legacy T A - State by \$13,511,000. Increases General Fund - Federal by \$65,000.

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
