EFFECT: Requires the Department of Ecology (DOE) to report to the Legislature on (1) whether DOE has adopted enforceable schedules for the operators of the Hanford nuclear reservation to empty leaking nuclear waste tanks and to use borehole or other increased environmental monitoring at tanks which are at high risk of leaking and (2) the status of U.S. Department of Energy budget requests to empty tanks, construct new storage capacity, or use existing commercial, permitted treatment capacity in the vicinity of the Hanford nuclear reservation to treat waste from leaking single shell tanks.
