1 On page 1, beginning on line 3 of the striking amendment, after 2 "Sec. 1." strike all material through "assistance." on page 2, line 5 3 and insert "The legislature acknowledges that paraeducators have 4 become a significant resource to students who need additional 5 education assistance. The legislature further recognizes that there 6 is significant variability in paraeducator standards, training, and 7 opportunity for professional development. A carefully constructed 8 paraeducator development program would place the highest qualified 9 paraeducators working with the highest need students. Such a program 10 when combined with a career ladder could offer paraeducators real 11 opportunities for upward mobility. Since paraeducators more closely 12 reflect the cultural diversity of the student population, 13 development program and career ladder would be likely to encourage 14 more paraeducators to become teachers. Training teachers how to work 15 with a paraeducator in their classrooms could increase paraeducators' 16 ability to teach students who need additional assistance."

EFFECT: Shortens the legislative intent section for the bill by removing data about hours of instruction provided by paraeducators; removing findings about paraeducator knowledge, skills, and commitment to education; and removing findings about paraeducator training being reduced due to budget cuts.

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
