6 (1) The department and the health care authority shall develop a 7 plan to provide integrated managed health and mental health care for 8 foster children receiving care through the medical assistance program. 9 The plan shall detail the steps necessary to implement and operate a 10 fully integrated program for foster children, including development of 11 a service delivery system, benefit design, reimbursement mechanisms, 12 and standards for contracting with health plans. The plan must be 13 designed so that all of the requirements for providing mental health 14 services to children under the *T.R. v. Dreyfus and Porter* settlement 15 are met. The plan shall include an implementation timeline and 16 funding estimate. The department and the health care authority shall 17 submit the plan to the legislature by December 1, 2014.

18 (2) This section expires on July 1, 2015."

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20 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any 21 internal references accordingly.

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EFFECT: Directs the Department of Social and Health Services and the Health Care Authority to develop a plan to provide integrated managed health and mental health care for foster children enrolled in Medicaid. Requires the plan to address the necessary steps to implement and operate an integrated program for foster children. Requires the plan to meet the requirements for providing mental health services to children under the *T.R. v. Dreyfus and Porter* settlement. Requires the plan to be submitted to the

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Legislature by December 1, 2014.

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
