3 "Sec. 1. RCW 69.04.060 and 2003 c 53 s 314 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, any person who
6 violates any provision of RCW 69.04.040 is guilty of a misdemeanor and
7 shall on conviction thereof be subject to the following penalties:

8 (1) A fine of not more than two hundred dollars; or

9 (2) If the violation is committed after a conviction of such person
10 under this section has become final, imprisonment for not more than
11 thirty days, or a fine of not more than five hundred dollars, or both
12 such imprisonment and fine.

13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 69.04.928 and 2002 c 301 s 11 are each amended to read
14 as follows:

15 The department of agriculture (~~must~~) may:

16 (1) Develop a pamphlet that generally describes the labeling
17 requirements for seafood(~~as~~) as set forth in this chapter(~~and~~);

18 (2) Provide (~~an adequate quantity of~~) to the department of fish
19 and wildlife a website link to the pamphlet(~~s to the department of~~
20 fish and wildlife to distribute with the issuance of a direct retail
21 endorsement under RCW 77.65.510)); and

22 (3) Make the pamphlet available to holders of any license
23 associated with buying and selling fish or shellfish under chapter
24 77.65 RCW.

25 **Sec. 3.** RCW 69.04.932 and 1993 c 282 s 2 are each amended to read
26 as follows:

27 (~~Unless the context clearly requires otherwise,~~) The definitions

1 in this section apply throughout ((RCW 69.04.933 through 69.04.935))
2 this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

3 (1) "Commercially caught" means wild or hatchery-raised salmon
4 harvested in the wild by commercial fishers. The term does not apply
5 to farmed fish raised exclusively by private sector aquaculture.

6 (2) "Food fish" means fresh or saltwater finfish and other forms of
7 aquatic animal life other than crustaceans, mollusks, birds, and
8 mammals where the animal life is intended for human consumption.

9 (3) "Salmon" means all species of the genus *Oncorhynchus*, except
10 those classified as game fish in ((Title 77)) RCW 77.08.020, and
11 includes:

20 ((~~(2) "Commercially caught" means salmon harvested by commercial~~
21 ~~fishers.~~)) (4) "Shellfish" means crustaceans and all mollusks where the
22 animal life is intended for human consumption.

23 **Sec. 4.** RCW 69.04.933 and 1993 c 282 s 3 are each amended to read
24 as follows:

25 ((~~With the exception of a commercial fisher engaged in sales of~~
26 ~~fish to a fish buyer, no person may sell~~)) (1) It is unlawful to
27 knowingly sell or offer for sale at wholesale or retail any fresh
28 ((~~or~~)), frozen ((~~salmon~~)), or processed food fish or ((~~cultured aquatic~~
29 ~~salmon~~)) shellfish without identifying for the buyer at the point of
30 sale the species of ((~~salmon~~)) food fish or shellfish by its common
31 name ((~~to the buyer at the point of sale~~)), such that the buyer can
32 make an informed purchasing decision ((~~in purchasing~~)) for his or her
33 protection, health, and safety. ((~~A person knowingly violating this~~
34 section is guilty of misbranding under this chapter. A person who
35 receives misleading or erroneous information about the species of

1 ~~salmon and subsequently inaccurately identifies salmon shall not be~~
2 ~~guilty of misbranding. This section shall not apply to salmon that is~~
3 ~~minced, pulverized, coated with batter, or breaded.))~~

4 (2) It is unlawful to knowingly label or offer for sale any food
5 fish designated as halibut, with or without additional descriptive
6 words, unless the food fish product is *Hippoglossus hippoglossus* or
7 *Hippoglossus stenolepsis*.

8 (3) This section does not apply to salmon that is minced,
9 pulverized, coated with batter, or breaded.

10 (4) This section does not apply to a commercial fisher properly
11 licensed under chapter 77.65 RCW and engaged in sales of fish to a fish
12 buyer.

13 (5) A violation of this section constitutes misbranding under
14 section 7 of this act and is punishable as a misdemeanor, gross
15 misdemeanor, or felony depending on the fair market value of the fish
16 or shellfish involved in the violation.

17 (6)(a) The common names for salmon species are as listed in RCW
18 69.04.932.

19 (b) The common names for all other food fish and shellfish are the
20 common names for food fish and shellfish species as defined by rule of
21 the director. If the common name for a species is not defined by rule
22 of the director, then the common name is the acceptable market name or
23 common name as provided in the United States food and drug
24 administration's publication "Seafood list - FDA's guide to acceptable
25 market names for seafood sold in interstate commerce," as the
26 publication existed on the effective date of this section.

27 (7) For the purposes of this section, "processed" means food fish
28 or shellfish processed by heat for human consumption, such as food fish
29 or shellfish that is kippered, smoked, boiled, canned, cleaned,
30 portioned, or prepared for sale or attempted sale for human
31 consumption.

32 (8) Nothing in this section precludes using additional descriptive
33 language or trade names to describe food fish or shellfish as long as
34 the labeling requirements in this section are met. Additionally, any
35 person using the common name "keta" to identify the species
36 *Ornncorhynchus keta* as authorized under subsection (6) of this section
37 must also use the additional descriptive term "dog salmon."

1 **Sec. 5.** RCW 69.04.934 and 2003 c 39 s 29 are each amended to read
2 as follows:

3 ~~((With the exception of a commercial fisher engaged in sales of
4 fish to a fish buyer, no person may sell at wholesale or retail any
5 fresh or frozen*))~~

6 (1) It is unlawful to knowingly sell or offer for sale at wholesale
7 or retail any fresh, frozen, or processed salmon without identifying
8 private sector cultured aquatic salmon ((without identifying the)) or
9 salmon products as farm-raised salmon((+or

10 +2))), or identifying commercially caught salmon ((designated as
11 food fish under Title 77 RCW without identifying the)) or salmon
12 products as commercially caught salmon.

13 (2) Identification of the products under subsection((s)) (1) ((and
14 +2))) of this section ((shall)) must be made to the buyer at the point
15 of sale such that the buyer can make an informed purchasing decision
16 ((in purchasing)) for his or her protection, health, and safety.

17 (3) A ((person knowingly violating)) violation of this section ((is
18 guilty of)) constitutes misbranding under ((this chapter. A person who
19 receives misleading or erroneous information about whether the salmon
20 is farm-raised or commercially caught, and subsequently inaccurately
21 identifies salmon shall not be guilty of misbranding)) section 7 of
22 this act and is punishable as a misdemeanor, gross misdemeanor, or
23 felony depending on the fair market value of the fish or shellfish
24 involved in the violation.

25 (4) This section ((shall)) does not apply to salmon that is minced,
26 pulverized, coated with batter, or breaded.

27 (5) This section does not apply to a commercial fisher properly
28 licensed under chapter 77.65 RCW and lawfully engaged in the sale of
29 fish to a fish buyer.

30 (6) Nothing in this section precludes using additional descriptive
31 language or trade names to describe food fish or shellfish as long as
32 the labeling requirements of this section are met.

33 **Sec. 6.** RCW 69.04.935 and 1994 c 264 s 39 are each amended to read
34 as follows:

35 To promote honesty and fair dealing for consumers and to protect
36 public health and safety, the director, in consultation with the

1 director of the department of fish and wildlife, (~~shall~~) may adopt
2 rules as necessary to:

3 (1) (~~Fixing and establishing~~) Establish and implement a
4 reasonable definition and identification standard (~~of identity for~~
5 ~~salmon for purposes of identifying and selling salmon~~) for species of
6 food fish and shellfish that are sold for human consumption;

7 (2) (~~Enforcing RCW 69.04.933 and 69.04.934~~) Provide procedures
8 for enforcing this chapter's food fish and shellfish labeling
9 requirements and misbranding prohibitions.

10 NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. A new section is added to chapter 69.04 RCW
11 to read as follows:

12 (1) A person is guilty of unlawful misbranding of food fish or
13 shellfish in the third degree if the person commits an act that
14 violates RCW 69.04.933 or 69.04.934, and the misbranding involves food
15 fish or shellfish with a fair market value up to five hundred dollars.
16 Unlawful misbranding of food fish or shellfish in the third degree is
17 a misdemeanor.

18 (2) A person is guilty of unlawful misbranding of food fish or
19 shellfish in the second degree if the person commits an act that
20 violates RCW 69.04.933 or 69.04.934, and the misbranding involves food
21 fish or shellfish with a fair market value of five hundred dollars or
22 more, up to five thousand dollars. Unlawful misbranding of food fish
23 or shellfish in the second degree is a gross misdemeanor.

24 (3) A person is guilty of unlawful misbranding of food fish or
25 shellfish in the first degree if the person commits an act that
26 violates RCW 69.04.933 or 69.04.934, and the misbranding involves food
27 fish or shellfish with a fair market value of five thousand dollars or
28 more. Unlawful misbranding of food fish or shellfish in the first
29 degree is a class C felony.

30 **Sec. 8.** RCW 9.94A.515 and 2012 c 176 s 3 and 2012 c 162 s 1 are
