3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The health care authority, department of
4 social and health services, and department of health shall collaborate
5 to identify goals and benchmarks while also developing individual
6 agency plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in Washington, improve
7 diabetes care, and better control the medical complications and
8 financial impacts associated with diabetes.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The health care authority, department of
10 social and health services, and department of health shall submit a
11 coordinated report to the governor and the appropriate committees of
12 the legislature by December 31, 2014, and every even-numbered year
13 thereafter, on the following:

14 (1) The financial impacts and reach that diabetes of all types and
15 undiagnosed gestational diabetes are having on the programs
16 administered by each agency and individuals, including children with
17 mothers with undiagnosed gestational diabetes, enrolled in those
18 programs. Items in this assessment must include: (a) The number of
19 lives with diabetes and undiagnosed gestational diabetes impacted or
20 covered by the programs administered by each agency; (b) the number of
21 lives with diabetes, or at risk for diabetes, and family members
22 impacted by prevention and diabetes control programs implemented by
23 each agency; (c) the financial toll or impact diabetes and its
24 complications, and undiagnosed gestational diabetes and the
25 complications experienced during labor to children of mothers with
26 gestational diabetes places on these programs in comparison to other
27 chronic diseases and conditions; and (d) the financial toll or impact
28 diabetes and its complications, and diagnosed gestational diabetes and

1 the complications experienced during labor to children of mothers with
2 gestational diabetes places on these programs;

3 (2) An assessment of the benefits of implemented and existing
4 programs and activities aimed at controlling all types of diabetes and
5 preventing the disease. This assessment must also document the amount
6 and source for any funding directed to each agency for the programs and
7 activities aimed at reaching those with diabetes of all types;

8 (3) A description of the level of coordination existing between the
9 agencies on activities, programmatic activities, and messaging on
10 managing, treating, or preventing all types of diabetes and its
11 complications;

12 (4) The development or revision of detailed policy-related action
13 plans and budget recommendations for battling diabetes and undiagnosed
14 gestational diabetes that includes a range of actionable items for
15 consideration by the legislature. The plans and budget recommendations
16 must identify proposed action steps to reduce the impact of diabetes,
17 prediabetes, related diabetes complications, and undiagnosed
18 gestational diabetes. The plans and budget recommendations must also
19 identify expected outcomes of the action steps proposed in the
20 following biennium while also establishing benchmarks for controlling
21 and preventing all types of diabetes; and

22 (5) An estimate of savings, efficiencies, costs, and budgetary
23 savings and resources required to implement the plans and budget
24 recommendations identified in subsection (4) of this section.

25 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act constitute a
26 new chapter in Title 70 RCW."
