- 19 impacts on consumers and the insurance market; and
- 20 (c) Suggested statutory changes required in order to implement the
- 21 new private health benefit exchanges.
- 22 (3) The current exchange may continue to operate after
- 23 implementation of the private health benefit exchanges. However, the
- 24 current exchange shall receive no special treatment or aid that would
- 25 create an unlevel playing field or advantage over the private health
- 26 benefit exchanges."

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EFFECT: By July 1, 2014, the Health Benefit Exchange must submit a waiver request to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to authorize Washington to explore the opportunity of offering multiple private health benefit exchanges in the state by January 1, 2016.

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
