1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.28 RCW  
4 to read as follows:

5 (1) The board must adopt rules by January 1, 2015, that require  
6 each spirits retail licensee that is licensed to sell spirits in  
7 original containers to consumers for consumption off the licensed  
8 premises, to report to the board quarterly, any and all loss of  
9 spirits, due to theft, breakage, loss, or diversion. The report must  
10 include the amount of spirits that is stolen, broken, lost, or diverted  
11 by type of spirits, manner of loss, and retail value. Spirits retail  
12 licensees required to report under this section must report the retail  
13 cost of the loss of spirits.

14 (2) The board must report to the appropriate committees of  
15 legislature annually the amount of spirits stolen, broken, lost, or  
16 diverted. The report must include the amount of loss totals, such as  
17 the amount and retail value, by each licensed retail establishment as  
18 well as the total value of the lost, taxes, and fees. Information must  
19 be made available to the public in a searchable format on a web site  
20 maintained by the board. The first report is due by January 1, 2016."

21 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "retailers;" strike the  
22 remainder of the title and insert "and adding a new section to chapter

EFFECT: The Liquor Control Board must adopt rules by January 1, 2015, requiring spirits retail licensees to report theft or loss of spirits on a quarterly basis. A report to the legislature is required by January 1, 2016, and information must be available to the public in a searchable format on a LCB web site.
