- 1 actions taken by the secretary were inadequate, the legislature may 2 take additional action to correct the problem.
- 3 (3) Within ninety days of the effective date of this section, a 4 report must be submitted on engineering errors that have occurred on 5 projects that are currently under construction and not yet 6 operationally complete."
