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- 7 On page 88, line 6, after "audit." Insert the following:
- 8 "Authorizations for the working connections child care subsidy are
- 9 effective for twelve months. A child is eligible for working
- 10 connections child care for a twelve-month enrollment period and may
- 11 not be deemed ineligible due to any change in circumstance including,
- 12 but not limited to, the following:
- (i) A change in family composition or household;
- (ii) A change in a parent's or a caregiver's employment status;
- 15 (iii) A change in a parent's or a caregiver's employment status
- 16 due to health, maternity or paternity leave, or other family leave
- 17 condition as provided for in chapter 49.78 RCW; or
- 18 (iv) A change in a parent's or a caregiver's income.
- 19 When an applicant or recipient applies for or receives working

- 21 required to notify the department of social and health services,
- 22 within five days, of any change in providers."

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- On page, 263, after line 15, insert the following:
- 25 "Sec. 910. RCW 43.215.135 and 2013 c 323 s 9 are each amended to read
- 26 as follows:

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- 1 (1) The department shall establish and implement policies in the 2 working connections child care program to promote stability and 3 quality of care for children from low-income households. Policies for 4 the expenditure of funds constituting the working connections child 5 care program must be consistent with the outcome measures defined in 6 RCW 74.08A.410 and the standards established in this section intended 7 to promote continuity of care for children.
- 8 (2) Beginning in fiscal year 2013, authorizations for the working 9 connections child care subsidy shall be effective for twelve months 10 unless a change in circumstances necessitates reauthorization sooner 11 than twelve months. The twelve-month certification applies only if 12 the enrollments in the child care subsidy or working connections child 13 care program are capped. However, during the 2013-15 fiscal biennium, 14 a child shall not be deemed ineligible due to a change in circumstance 15 during the twelve month period, as provided in the omnibus 16 appropriations act.
- (3) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this specific purpose, beginning September 1, 2013, working connections 19 child care providers shall receive a five percent increase in the 20 subsidy rate for enrolling in level 2 in the early achievers programs. 21 Providers must complete level 2 and advance to level 3 within thirty 22 months in order to maintain this increase."

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 $\underline{\text{EFFECT:}}$ Requires the department of social and health services to establish 12 month authorizations for the Working Connections Child Care program during the 2013-15 fiscal biennium.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$10,000,000 general fund state in fiscal year 2015

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
