- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 7.69 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- (1) At all criminal proceedings before a court, the presiding 6 7 officer shall inquire as to the presence of the victim and/or a survivor of the victim and, whether the victim is present or not, shall 9 read the following:
 - "Victims of crime have rights under Washington law with the intent to ensure that all victims and witnesses of crime are treated with dignity, respect, courtesy, and sensitivity; and that the rights of victims, survivors of victims, and witnesses of crime are honored and protected by law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, and judges in a manner no less vigorous than the protections afforded criminal defendants. A flier with the complete list of victim rights is available outside this courtroom."
