- 10 premises, overlapping premises, adjacent premises, or separate premises
- 11 to the same licensee or to different licensees, including different

- 13 (2) Nothing in this section prohibits different licensees from
- 14 allocating distinct parts of a single business location to their

- if the board does not connect a violation of RCW 66.44.200 or 66.44.270
