- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 Sec. 1. RCW 42.52.160 and 1996 c 213 s 7 are each amended to read as follows: 6
- (1) No state officer or state employee may employ or use any person, money, or property under the officer's or employee's official control or direction, or in his or her official custody, for the private benefit or gain of the officer, employee, or another. 10
- 11 (2) This section does not prohibit the use of public resources to 12 benefit others as part of a state officer's or state employee's official duties. 13
- (3) This section does not prohibit de minimis use of state 14 facilities to provide employees with information about (a) medical, 15 16 surgical, and hospital care; (b) life insurance or accident and health
- disability insurance; or (c) individual retirement accounts, by any 17
- person, firm, or corporation administering such program as part of 18
- 19 authorized payroll deductions pursuant to RCW 41.04.020.

(4) The appropriate ethics boards may adopt rules providing exceptions to this section for occasional use of the state officer or state employee, of de minimis cost and value, if the activity does not result in interference with the proper performance of public duties.
