- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 67.70 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 Beginning September 1, 2014, the director or the director's designee may begin:
  - (1) Selling internet advertisements for display on the state lottery web site subject to the following conditions:
- 10 (a) The web site must include a disclaimer indicating the inclusion of advertisements does not imply endorsement by the state;
- 12 (b) Prior to selling advertisements, the commission must establish policy, style, and content guidelines for advertisements;
- 14 (c) Revenue generated from the sale of internet advertisements must 15 be deposited in the state lottery account created in RCW 67.70.230; and
- 16 (d) The advertisement must not display or promote a practice that 17 is prohibited under state or federal gaming laws.
- 18 (2) Charging for the use of the state lottery logo and trademark 19 subject to the following conditions:
