1 AN ACT Relating to Congressional Medal of Honor special license 2 plates; and amending RCW 46.18.230.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 46.18.230 and 2011 c 332 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) A registered owner who has been awarded the Congressional Medal
of Honor may apply to the department for special license plates for use
on ((a)) no more than two motor vehicles required to display one or two
license plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW,
upon terms and conditions established by the department. The
Congressional Medal of Honor recipient must:

12 (a) Provide proof from the Washington state department of veterans13 affairs showing receipt of the medal; and

(b) Be recorded as <u>one of</u> the registered owner<u>s</u> of the motor vehicle on which the Congressional Medal of Honor license plate or plates will be displayed.

17 (2) Congressional Medal of Honor license plates must be issued:18 (a) Only for a personal motor vehicle owned by persons who have

19 received the Congressional Medal of Honor; and

(b) Without payment of vehicle license fees, license plate fees,
 and motor vehicle excise taxes.

3 (3) Congressional Medal of Honor license plates must be replaced,
4 free of charge, if the license plates become lost, stolen, damaged,
5 defaced, or destroyed.

6 (4) A Congressional Medal of Honor license plate or plates may be 7 transferred, free of charge, from one motor vehicle to another motor 8 vehicle owned by the Congressional Medal of Honor recipient upon 9 application to the department, county auditor or other agent, or 10 subagent appointed by the director.
