- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.05.180 and 1999 c 391 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

A person rendering emergency care or transportation, commonly known 6 7 as a "Good Samaritan," as described in RCW 4.24.300 and 4.24.310, may request and receive appropriate infectious disease testing free of 8 9 charge from the local health department of the county of her or his residence, if $((\div (1)))$ while rendering emergency care she or he came 10 into contact with bodily fluids((; and (2) she or he does not have 11 12 health insurance that covers the testing)). If consented to by the source patient, testing of the source patient may be performed in order 13 to quide postexposure prophylaxis treatment of the good samaritan. 14 Source patient testing may be requested and received free of charge 15 16 from the local health department of the county of his or her residence. Nothing in this section requires a local health department to provide 17

health care services beyond testing. The department shall adopt rules
