4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 47.80.040 and 2003 c 351 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 Each regional transportation planning organization shall create a transportation policy board. Transportation policy boards shall 8 9 provide policy advice to the regional transportation planning organization and shall allow representatives of major employers within 10 the region, the department of transportation, transit districts, port 11 districts, and member cities, towns, and counties within the region to 12 13 participate in policy making. Any members of the house of 14 representatives or the state senate whose districts are wholly or 15 partly within the boundaries of the regional transportation planning organization are considered ((ex officio, nonvoting)) voting policy 16 board members of the regional transportation planning organization. 17
