HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 4401

State of Washington 63rd Legislature 2013 Regular Session

WHEREAS, It is of paramount importance to establish cutoff dates for the consideration of legislation during the 2013 Regular Session of the Sixty-Third Legislature;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That the following cutoff dates apply to all bills, memorials, and joint resolutions with the exception of budgets, matters necessary to implement budgets, initiatives to the legislature, and alternatives to initiatives to the legislature:

(1) Friday, February 22, 2013, the fortieth day, will be the final day to read in committee reports in the house of origin, with the exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House of Representatives fiscal committees;

(2) Friday, March 1, 2013, the forty-seventh day, will be the final
day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
of Representatives fiscal committee reports in the house of origin;

(3) Wednesday, March 13, 2013, the fifty-ninth day, at 5:00 p.m.,
will be the final time to consider bills in their house of origin;

19 (4) Wednesday, April 3, 2013, the eightieth day, will be the final

day to read in committee reports on bills from the opposite house with
 the exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
 Transportation, and House of Representatives fiscal committees;

4 (5) Tuesday, April 9, 2013, the eighty-sixth day, will be the final
5 day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
6 of Representatives fiscal committee reports on bills from the opposite
7 house; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That after 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 8 17, 2013, the ninety-fourth day, neither house may consider any bills, 9 memorials, or joint resolutions except initiatives to the legislature 10 11 and alternatives to such initiatives, budgets and matters necessary to 12 implement budgets, messages pertaining to amendments, matters of 13 differences between the two houses, and matters incident to the interim and to the closing of the business of the 2013 Regular Session of the 14 15 Legislature.
