- AN ACT Relating to motorcycles overtaking and passing pedestrians and bicyclists; and amending RCW 46.61.608.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.608 and 1975 c 62 s 46 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) All motorcycles are entitled to full use of a lane and no motor vehicle shall be driven in such a manner as to deprive any motorcycle of the full use of a lane. This subsection shall not apply to motorcycles operated two abreast in a single lane.
 - (2) The operator of a motorcycle shall not overtake and pass in the same lane occupied by the vehicle being overtaken. <u>However, consistent</u> with RCW 46.61.110(2), this subsection shall not apply when the operator of a motorcycle overtakes and passes a pedestrian or bicyclist.
- 15 (3) No person shall operate a motorcycle between lanes of traffic 16 or between adjacent lines or rows of vehicles.
- 17 (4) Motorcycles shall not be operated more than two abreast in a single lane.

1 (5) Subsections (2) and (3) of this section shall not apply to police officers in the performance of their official duties.
