((The commission may make exceptions on a case by case basis for candidates whose authorized committees lack the technological ability to file reports using the electronic alternative provided by the commission.)) Each candidate or authorized committee of a candidate, that expended five thousand dollars or more in the preceding year or expects to expend five thousand dollars or more in the current year may file
