## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6518

State of Washington 63rd Legislature 2014 Regular Session

**By** Senate Trade & Economic Development (originally sponsored by Senator Chase; by request of Washington State Department of Commerce)

1 AN ACT Relating to terminating the operations of innovate 2 Washington and transferring property from innovate Washington to Washington State University and the department of commerce; adding a 3 4 new section to chapter 28B.30 RCW; creating a new section; repealing 43.333.010, 43.333.020, 43.333.030, 43.333.040, 43.333.050, 5 RCW 6 43.333.800, 43.333.900, 43.333.901, and 41.06.0711; and providing an 7 effective date.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature intends to dissolve the 10 operations of innovate Washington and transfer the innovate Washington 11 facilities to Washington State University.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28B.30 RCW 13 to read as follows:

(1) Innovate Washington shall work with the department of
enterprise services to have all real property, including real estate,
buildings, and facilities used by innovate Washington assigned to
Washington State University, including the building at 665 North

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Riverpoint Boulevard in Spokane, Washington and any remaining tenant
 leases and building obligations.

3 (2) All personal property associated with the building at 665 North
4 Riverpoint Boulevard in Spokane, Washington, including cabinets,
5 furniture, office equipment, motor vehicles, and other tangible
6 property used by innovate Washington is transferred to Washington State
7 University.

8 (3) Innovate Washington shall work with the department of 9 enterprise services to have the master lease for the Spokane technology 10 center building at 120 North Pine Street in Spokane, Washington 11 assigned to Washington State University.

12 (4) Innovate Washington shall work with the department of 13 enterprise services to have all data relating to the operations of innovate Washington transferred to the department of commerce. 14 The department of commerce is authorized to use such data in its current 15 and future business operations. All unused data, however, shall be 16 17 transferred to the Washington state archives for records management 18 purposes.

19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The following acts or parts of acts are each 20 repealed:

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act takes effect July 1, 2014.

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
