1 AN ACT Relating to the number of Puget Sound Dungeness crab fishery
2 licenses that one vessel may be designated to carry; and amending RCW
3 77.65.100 and 77.65.130.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.65.100 and 2005 c 82 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1) This section applies to all commercial fishery licenses,
8 delivery licenses, and charter licenses.

9 ~~((1))~~ (2) An applicant for a license subject to this section may
10 designate a vessel to be used with the license. Except for emergency
11 salmon delivery licenses, the director may issue a license regardless
12 of whether the applicant designates a vessel. An applicant may
13 designate no more than one vessel on a license subject to this section.

14 ~~((2))~~ (3) A license for a fishery that requires a vessel
15 authorizes no taking or delivery of food fish or shellfish unless a
16 vessel is designated on the license. A delivery license authorizes no
17 delivery of food fish or shellfish unless a vessel is designated on the
18 license.

1 (~~(3)~~) (4) No vessel may be designated on more than one commercial
2 fishery license unless the licenses are for different fisheries,
3 except:

4 (a) The same vessel may be designated on two of the following
5 licenses, provided the licenses are owned by the same licensee:

6 (i) Shrimp pot-Puget Sound fishery license;

7 (ii) Sea cucumber dive fishery license; and

8 (iii) Sea urchin dive fishery license.

9 (b) Subject to the provisions of RCW 77.65.130, the same vessel may
10 be designated on (~~two~~) three Puget Sound Dungeness crab fishery
11 licenses(~~(, subject to the provision of RCW 77.65.130)~~) issued pursuant
12 to RCW 77.70.110.

13 (~~(4)~~) (5) No vessel may be designated on more than one delivery
14 license, on more than one salmon charter license, or on more than one
15 nonsalmon charter license.

16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.65.130 and 2005 c 82 s 2 are each amended to read
17 as follows:

18 (1) A person who holds a commercial fishery license or a delivery
19 license may operate the vessel designated on the license. A person who
20 is not the license holder may operate the vessel designated on the
21 license only if:

22 (a) The person holds an alternate operator license issued by the
23 director; and

24 (b) The person is designated as an alternate operator on the
25 underlying commercial fishery license or delivery license under RCW
26 77.65.110.

27 (2) Only an individual at least sixteen years of age may hold an
28 alternate operator license.

29 (3) No individual may hold more than one alternate operator
30 license. An individual who holds an alternate operator license may be
31 designated as an alternate operator on an unlimited number of
32 commercial fishery licenses or delivery licenses under RCW 77.65.110.

33 (4) An individual who holds (~~two~~) multiple Dungeness crab--Puget
34 Sound fishery licenses issued pursuant to RCW 77.70.110 may operate the
35 licenses on one vessel if the license holder or alternate operator is
36 on the vessel. The department shall allow a license holder to operate
37 up to one hundred crab pots for each license.

1 (5) Two persons owning separate Dungeness crab--Puget Sound fishery
2 licenses may operate (~~both~~) their licenses on one vessel if the
3 license holders or their alternate operators are on the vessel.

4 (6) As used in this section, to "operate" means to control the
5 deployment or removal of fishing gear from state waters while aboard a
6 vessel or to operate a vessel delivering food fish or shellfish taken
7 in offshore waters to a port within the state.
