- 8 account is created in the custody of the state treasurer. All moneys

- 10 property, and equipment must be deposited into the account. The
- 11 sources of the moneys generated and deposited under this section may
- 12 include federal, state, local, or private grants, consistent with RCW
- 13 43.101.190. Expenditures from the account may be used only for cost
- 14 related to rental, maintenance, or development of the commission's
- 15 firing range facilities, property, and equipment. Only the executive
