1 AN ACT Relating to removing the requirements that all fines
2 collected be credited to the Washington horse racing commission class
3 C purse fund account; and amending RCW 67.16.270.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 67.16.270 and 2004 c 246 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 Upon making a determination that an individual or licensee has
8 violated a commission rule, the board of stewards may assess a fine,
9 suspend or revoke a person's license, or any combination of these
10 penalties. The commission must adopt by rule standard penalties for a
11 rules violation. All fines collected must be deposited in the
12 Washington horse racing commission ~~((class C purse fund account,~~
13 ~~created in RCW 67.16.285, and used as authorized in RCW 67.16.105(3).))~~
14 operating account. The funds accrued by the assessed fines will be
15 used to support nonprofit race meets as authorized in RCW 67.16.280(2).
16 If no dates for nonprofit racing are requested or approved, the fines
17 will remain in the Washington horse racing commission operating

1 account.
