1 AN ACT Relating to the submission of new master applications by
2 persons seeking work permits for the employment of minors; and adding
3 a new section to chapter 19.02 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.02 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 A person seeking a work permit for the employment of minors under
8 RCW 49.12.121 is not required to complete an entirely new master
9 application if there are no changes to any other information submitted
10 on the most recent master application. The person need only complete
11 the parts of a new master application that identify the employer
12 seeking the minor work permit, including address and contact
13 information, and that indicate the employer plans to employ one or more
14 minors, the duties to be performed by minors, and the estimated number
15 of hours to be worked by minors.
