1 AN ACT Relating to the recoverable costs of the department of
2 agriculture under chapter 16.36 RCW; and amending RCW 16.36.025.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 16.36.025 and 2011 c 204 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) The director may collect moneys to recover the reasonable costs
7 of purchasing, printing, and distributing official individual
8 identification devices or methods, regulatory forms, and other
9 supplies.

10 (2) In addition to the costs identified in subsection (1) of this
11 section, the director may also collect moneys to recover the reasonable
12 costs associated with the data entry and processing related to animal
13 health documents that facilitate disease control and traceability.

14 (3) All funds received under this section must be deposited in the
15 animal disease traceability account in the agricultural local fund
16 created in RCW 43.23.230 to cover the costs associated with this
17 chapter.
