1 AN ACT Relating to eliminating lottery games that generate 2 insufficient net revenue; amending RCW 67.70.240; and repealing RCW 3 67.70.500.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 67.70.240 and 2011 c 352 s 3 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 <u>(1)</u> The moneys in the state lottery account ((shall)) may be used 8 only:

9 ((<del>(1)</del>)) <u>(a)</u> For the payment of prizes to the holders of winning 10 lottery tickets or shares;

11  $((\frac{(2)}{)})$  (b) For purposes of making deposits into the reserve 12 account created by RCW 67.70.250 and into the lottery administrative 13 account created by RCW 67.70.260;

14 ((<del>(3)</del>)) <u>(c)</u> For purposes of making deposits into the ((education 15 construction-fund-created-in-RCW-43.135.045-and-the)) Washington 16 opportunity pathways account created in RCW 28B.76.526. ((On and after 17 July 1, 2010, all deposits not otherwise obligated under this section 18 shall-be-placed-in-the-Washington-opportunity-pathways-account.))

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Moneys in the state lottery account deposited in the Washington opportunity pathways account are included in "general state revenues" under RCW 39.42.070;

4 (((4) For distribution to a county for the purpose of paying the 5 principal-and-interest-payments-on-bonds-issued-by-the-county-to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including 6 7 reasonably-necessary-preconstruction-costs. Three-million-dollars 8 shall be distributed under this subsection during calendar year 1996. During-subsequent-years,-such-distributions-shall-equal-the-prior 9 10 year's distributions increased by four percent.
