1            AN ACT Relating to a proclamation of a state of emergency; and  
2 amending RCW 43.06.210.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.06.210 and 1977 ex.s. c 328 s 12 are each amended  
5 to read as follows:

6            The proclamation of a state of emergency and other proclamations or  
7 orders issued by the governor pursuant to RCW 43.06.010, and 43.06.200  
8 through 43.06.270 as now or hereafter amended shall be in writing and  
9 shall be signed by the governor and shall then be filed with the  
10 secretary of state. A proclamation of a state of emergency is  
11 effective upon the governor's signature. The governor shall give as  
12 much public notice as practical through the news media of the issuance  
13 of proclamations or orders pursuant to RCW 43.06.010, and 43.06.200  
14 through 43.06.270 as now or hereafter amended. The state of emergency  
15 shall cease to exist upon the issuance of a proclamation of the  
16 governor declaring its termination: PROVIDED, That the governor must  
17 terminate said state of emergency proclamation when order has been

1 restored in the area affected.
