- If the board of directors of a school district provides access to the campus and the student information directory to persons or groups
- 8 which make students aware of occupational or educational options, the
- 9 board shall provide access ((on the same basis)) to official recruiting
- 10 representatives of the job corps, peace corps, and AmeriCorps, and to
- 11 official recruiting representatives of the military forces of the state
- 12 and the United States for the purpose of informing students of
- 13 educational and career opportunities available in the military, which
- 14 <u>must be equal to and no less than access provided to other</u>
