1 On page 291, after line 15, insert the following:

2 "(3) Within amounts appropriated in this section, the energy  
3 facility site evaluation council must submit a report to the  
4 legislature consistent with RCW 43.01.036 by December 15, 2015, that  
5 evaluates the economic feasibility, regulatory impediments, and net  
6 effect to public safety, the environment, and localized employment  
7 related to the construction of a pipeline to transport crude oil  
8 across the state as an alternative to the transport of crude oil by  
9 train or vessel."

EFFECT: Requires the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council  
(who receive administrative support from the Utilities and  
Transportation Commission) to submit a report that evaluates the  
construction of a pipeline to transport crude oil across the state  
as an alternative to the transport of crude oil by train or vessel.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
