EFFECT: Assumes the passage of ESSB 5954 (college affordability program). Reduces tuition for resident undergraduate students to a percentage of the state average wage. Aligns state financial aid programs to mirror the changes in tuition rates. Provides additional funding to offset the loss of tuition revenue to institutions that results from the reduction in tuition rates.

Removes funding previously provided to institutions of higher education to freeze tuition. Reduces the State Need Grant appropriation by \$53,000,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases General Fund - State by \$121,202,000.

Reduces Education Legacy T A - State by \$155,117,000.

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
