- 4 Unless a different meaning is plainly required by the context,
- 5 the following words and phrases as hereinafter used in RCW
- 6 43.06.010, and 43.06.200 through 43.06.270 each as now or hereafter
- 7 amended shall have the following meaning:
- 8 "State of emergency" means an emergency proclaimed as such by
- 9 the governor pursuant to RCW 43.06.010 as now or hereafter amended.
- "Governor" means the governor of this state or, in case of his
- 11 or her removal, death, resignation or inability to discharge the
- 12 powers and duties of his or her office, then the person who may
- 13 exercise the powers of governor pursuant to the Constitution and
- 14 laws of this state relating to succession in office.
- 15 "Criminal offense" means any prohibited act for which any
- 16 criminal penalty is imposed by law and includes any misdemeanor,
- 17 gross misdemeanor, or felony.
- 18 "Cybersecurity incident" means a breach of one or more state
- 19 information technology systems or an occurrence or threat, that: (1)
- 20 jeopardizes the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of state
- 21 information technology systems which includes but is not limited to
- 22 any incident that stores, transmits, or constitutes a violation or
- 23 imminent threat of violation of state security policies or
- 24 procedures; and (2) requires significant state expenditures to
- 25 repair and protect state information technology systems and data, or
- 26 requires significant state expenditures for state liability
- 27 resulting from the breach. For the purposes of this section,

1	"significant	state	expenditures"	means	expenditures	as	estimated	b	v

- 2 the office of financial management or successor agency that exceed
- 3 one-half of one percent of general state revenues as calculated
- 4 under Article VIII, section 1 of the Constitution.

6 Correct the title.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Defines "cybersecurity incident" as it relates to when a governor can proclaim a state of emergency.
