Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:

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4 "Sec. 1. RCW 19.28.211 and 2013 c 23 s 33 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (1) The department shall issue a certificate of competency to 7 all applicants who have passed the examination provided in RCW 8 19.28.201, met the in-class education requirements of RCW 19.28.205 9 if applicable, and who have complied with RCW 19.28.161 through 10 19.28.271 and the rules adopted under this chapter. An applicant who 11 qualified for certification by completing a journey level or 12 residential specialty electrical construction trade apprenticeship 13 under chapter 49.04 RCW shall be issued a journey level or 14 residential specialty certificate of competency, as applicable, or 15 master journey level or master residential specialty certificate of 16 competency, as applicable, if the applicant otherwise qualifies 17 under this chapter, with an indication that the individual completed 18 a journey level or residential specialty electrical construction 19 trade apprenticeship program under chapter 49.04 RCW. The 20 certificate may include a photograph of the holder. The certificate 21 shall bear the date of issuance, and shall expire on the holder's 22 birthday. The certificate shall be renewed every three years, upon 23 application, on or before the holder's birthdate. A fee shall be 24 assessed for each certificate and for each annual renewal.

25 (2) If the certificate holder demonstrates to the department 26 that he or she has satisfactorily completed an annual eight-hour 27 continuing education course, the certificate may be renewed without 1 examination by appropriate application unless the certificate has 2 been revoked, suspended, or not renewed within ninety days after the 3 expiration date. For pump and irrigation or domestic pump specialty 4 electricians, the continuing education course may combine both 5 electrical and plumbing education provided that there is a minimum 6 of four hours of electrical training in the course.

7 (a) The contents and requirements for satisfactory completion of 8 the continuing education course shall be determined by the director 9 and approved by the board.

10 (b) The department shall accept proof of a certificate holder's 11 satisfactory completion of a continuing education course offered in 12 another state as meeting the requirements for maintaining a current 13 Washington state certificate of competency if the department is 14 satisfied the course is comparable in nature to that required in 15 Washington state for maintaining a current certificate of 16 competency.

17 (3) If the certificate is not renewed before the expiration 18 date, the individual shall pay twice the usual fee. The department 19 shall set the fees by rule for issuance and renewal of a certificate 20 of competency. The fees shall cover but not exceed the costs of 21 issuing the certificates and of administering and enforcing the 22 electrician certification requirements of this chapter.

23 (4) The certificates of competency and temporary permits 24 provided for in this chapter grant the holder the right to work in 25 the electrical construction trade as a master electrician, journey 26 level electrician, or specialty electrician in accordance with their 27 provisions throughout the state and within any of its political 28 subdivisions without additional proof of competency or any other 29 license, permit, or fee to engage in such work."

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31 Correct the title.

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EFFECT: Strikes the underlying House Bill and provides that an applicant for a journey level or residential specialty electrician certificate of competency, or master journey level or residential specialty electrician certificate, who qualified by completing an apprenticeship must be issued a certificate indicating that the electrician completed an apprenticeship program.

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
