On page 2, beginning on line 33, after "overdose." strike all material through "professional."" on line 36 and insert "At the time of dispensing an opioid overdose medication, a pharmacist shall provide written instructions on the proper response to an opioidrelated overdose. The instructions must be affixed to the container in which the medication is dispensed and must inform the recipient to call 911 and seek medical attention immediately."

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EFFECT: Removes the requirement that a pharmacist affix a label on the cap of the prescription. Requires a pharmacist dispensing an opioid overdose medication to provide written instructions on the proper response to an opioid-related overdose. Requires the instructions to be affixed to the container in which the medication is dispensed and to inform the recipient to call 911 and seek medical attention immediately.

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
