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4 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The chief of the Washington state 5 patrol, through the director of fire protection, must convene a work 6 group on the regulation of consumer fireworks in Washington. The 7 work group, at a minimum, must include:

8 (a) The director of fire protection, or his or her designee;
9 (b) A representative of the association of Washington cities;
10 (c) A representative of the Washington state association of

11 counties;

12 (d) A representative of the fireworks industry; and

13 (e) A representative of the Washington state council of fire14 fighters.

15 (2) The work group shall review issues related to state and 16 local regulation of consumer fireworks, the scope of local 17 government authority to regulate fireworks, and the adoption of a 18 uniform, statewide fireworks standard.

19 (3) Staff support for the work group must be provided by the 20 Washington state patrol and the office of the state fire marshal. 21 (4)(a) The chief of the Washington state patrol, through the 22 director of fire protection, shall report the findings and 23 recommendations of the work group to the appropriate committees of 24 the legislature by January 1, 2016.

(b) The report must include recommendations for any legislative actions related to the regulation of consumer fireworks in Washington. 1 (5) This section expires June 1, 2016."

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3 Correct the title.

EFFECT: (1) Strikes all provisions of the underlying substitute bill. (2) Requires the Chief of the Washington State Patrol, through the Director of Fire Protection, to convene a work group on the regulation of consumer fireworks in Washington. (3) Provides for the work group's membership and staff support. (3) Requires the work group to report its findings and recommendations to the appropriate committees of the Legislature by January 1, 2016.

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
