5 <u>(I) Has separated from the uniformed services with any period of</u> 6 <u>honorable service after at least ninety days of active duty service;</u> 7 <u>(II) Is eligible for benefits under the federal all-volunteer</u> 8 <u>force educational assistance program (38 U.S.C. Sec. 3001 et seq.),</u> 9 <u>the federal post-9/11 veterans educational assistance act of 2008 (38</u> 10 <u>U.S.C. Sec. 3301 et seq.), or any other federal law authorizing</u> 11 <u>educational assistance benefits for veterans; and</u> 12 <u>(III) Enters</u> an institution of higher education in Washington

13 within ((one)) three years of the date of separation"

EFFECT: Adds that a student needs to be eligible for educational assistance benefits for veterans in order to qualify for resident student status.
