1 On page 41, beginning on line 14, after "created" strike all material
2 through "commission." on line 22 and insert ", located within the office
3 of financial management. Except as provided in RCW 9.94A.875, the
4 commission shall serve to advise the governor and the legislature as
5 necessary on issues relating to adult and juvenile sentencing. The
6 commission may meet, as necessary, to accomplish these purposes within
7 funds appropriated."

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9 On page 43, beginning on line 17, after "**Sec. 14.**" strike all
10 material through "(3)" on line 38 and insert "(1) (a) Subject to funds
11 appropriated specifically for this purpose, the sentencing guidelines
12 commission working in conjunction with the caseload forecast council
13 and the statistical analysis center as described in subsections (2) and
14 (3) of this section, as well as other entities as needed, shall review
15 the impacts of sentencing under the property crime grid in this act
16 which include:

17 (i) Property crime rates;

18 (ii) Recidivism rates, as measured by rearrest;

19 (iii) Supervision, jail, and prison populations; and

20 (iv) Racial disproportionality among offenders sentenced for
21 property crimes.

22 (b) No later than January 1st of each odd-numbered year, the
23 commission shall submit a report to the appropriate committees of the
24 legislature that includes:

25 (i) The determinations described in subsection (1) (a) of this
26 section and the methodology employed by the commission in reaching
27 those determinations;

1 (ii) An overview and the effectiveness of the grant programs
2 established under this act; and

3 (iii) Recommendations for changes to the property crime grid
4 established in this act to further reduce the rate of property
5 crime.

6 (2) The caseload forecast council shall supply the commission
7 with data relating to sentencing under the property crime grid on
8 property crime rates, supervision, jail and prison populations, and
9 racial disproportionality.

10 (3) The statistical analysis center located in the office of
11 financial management shall supply the commission with a report on
12 property crime recidivism rates and data as to the effectiveness of
13 the law enforcement grant program established under this act.

14 (4)"

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16 On page 44, beginning on line 3, strike all of section 15

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18 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
19 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires the Sentencing Guidelines Commission (SGC) to review crime rates, incarceration rates, and racial disproportionality among offenders, due to sentencing under the new property crime grid as reported by the Caseload Forecast Council and Statistical Analysis Center as well as the effectiveness of the grant programs established under the act. Deletes the new provision that requires the SGC to be colocated within the Caseload Forecast Council.

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
