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estimated costs for enforcement of WAC 162-32-060, concerning gender-segregated facilities, for the current and next biennia. Requires the Joint Legislative and Audit Committee (JLARC) to conduct a study of the fiscal impacts of the WAC 162-32-060, concerning gender-segregated facilities, on businesses and the Human Rights Commission. Requires JLARC to present a report with any findings and recommendations to the appropriate fiscal committees of the legislature.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.

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
