1 On page 149, after line 20, insert the following:
2 "(19) For the purposes of evaluating the requirements of RCW
3 70.95.290, the department, in consultation with the Washington
4 materials management and financing authority, shall, within existing
5 resources, report to the appropriate committees of the legislature on
6 whether the department and Washington materials management and
7 financing authority have utilized existing infrastructure for the
8 collection of electronics. In its report, the department, in
9 consultation with the Washington materials management and financing
10 authority, must report on the location and number of new programs
11 created and depot systems developed since 2006 for the purpose of
12 collecting electronics, how many existing collections sites have been
13 utilized, as well as how many curbside collection companies were
14 contracted with for collection of electronics. The department must
15 submit the report to the appropriate committees of the legislature no
16 later than September 1, 2016."

EFFECT: Requires the Department of Ecology, in consultation with the Washington Materials Management and Financing Authority, to report to the legislature on whether existing infrastructure has been used for the collection of electronics.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
