- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this specific purpose, the department of 4 natural resources and the department of fish and wildlife must 5 collaborate to conduct a survey of the location of surf smelt and 6 7 sand lance spawning grounds throughout Puget Sound, including the Strait of Juan de Fuca. To the extent available, the departments of 8 natural resources and fish and wildlife must conduct the surveys 9 10 using crews of the veterans conservation corps created in RCW 43.60A.150. 11
- 12 (2) The results from the survey required under this section must 13 be used by the department of natural resources and the department of 14 fish and wildlife to expand knowledge of spawning habitat areas. The 15 survey results must be made accessible to the public.
- 16 (3) The survey required under this section must be completed by 17 June 30, 2017.
- 18 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) Subject to the availability of amounts 19 appropriated for this specific purpose, the department of fish and 20 wildlife must conduct a mid-water trawl survey at various depths throughout Puget Sound to evaluate the prevalence of adults of all 21 22 species of forage fish. The department must integrate the results of 23 the survey into existing Puget Sound ecosystem assessments to assist 24 department of fish and wildlife in the management conservation of forage fish species and the species that prey upon 25 26 them.
- 27 (2) The department of fish and wildlife must complete the survey 28 required under this section by June 30, 2017.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The legislature intends for the department of natural resources and the department of fish and wildlife to complete the survey required under section 1 of this act with funds

- 1 specifically appropriated from the state's capital budget for the
- 2 2015-2017 biennium.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act expires July 1, 2018." 3
- 4 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Provides legislative intent for the department of natural resources and the department of fish and wildlife to complete the spawning grounds survey with funds specifically appropriated from the state's capital budget for the 2015-2017 biennium and adds an expiration date.
