1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The health care authority, department of
4 social and health services, and department of health shall
5 collaborate to identify goals and benchmarks while also developing
6 individual agency plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in
7 Washington, improve diabetes care, and control complications
8 associated with diabetes.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The health care authority, department of
10 social and health services, and department of health shall each
11 submit a report to the governor and the legislature by December 31,
12 2019, and every second year thereafter, on the following:

13 (1) The financial impact and reach diabetes of all types is
14 having on programs administered by each agency and individuals
15 enrolled in those programs. Items included in this assessment must
16 include the number of lives with diabetes impacted or covered by
17 programs administered by the agency, the number of lives with
18 diabetes and family members impacted by prevention and diabetes
19 control programs implemented by the agency, the financial toll or
20 impact diabetes and its complications places on these programs, and
21 the financial toll or impact diabetes and its complications places on
22 these programs in comparison to other chronic diseases and
23 conditions;

24 (2) An assessment of the benefits of implemented programs and
25 activities aimed at controlling diabetes and preventing the disease.
26 This assessment must also document the amount and source for any
27 funding directed to the agency for programs and activities aimed at
28 reaching those with diabetes;

29 (3) A description of the level of coordination existing between
30 the agencies on activities, programmatic activities, and messaging on

1 managing, treating, or preventing all forms of diabetes and its
2 complications;

3 (4) A development or revision of detailed action plans for
4 battling diabetes with a range of actionable items for consideration
5 by the legislature. The plans must identify proposed action steps to
6 reduce the impact of diabetes, prediabetes, and related diabetes
7 complications. The plan must also identify expected outcomes of the
8 action steps proposed in the following biennium while also
9 establishing benchmarks for controlling and preventing relevant forms
10 of diabetes; and

11 (5) An estimate of costs and resources required to implement the
12 plan identified in subsection (4) of this section.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act constitute a
14 new chapter in Title 70 RCW."

15 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Changes the initial reporting date for the diabetes reports submitted by the Health Care Authority, the Department of Social and Health Services, and the Department of Health from December 31, 2017, to December 31, 2019.

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
