## HB 1113 - S COMM AMD By Committee on Law & Justice

- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "Sec. 1. RCW 26.04.050 and 2012 c 3 s 4 are each amended to read 4 as follows:

5 The following named officers and persons, active or retired, are hereby authorized to solemnize marriages, to wit: Justices of the 6 7 supreme court, judges of the court of appeals, judges of the superior courts, supreme court commissioners, court of appeals commissioners, 8 9 superior court commissioners, judges of courts of limited jurisdiction as defined in RCW 3.02.010, judges of tribal courts from 10 a federally recognized tribe, and any regularly licensed or ordained 11 12 minister or any priest, imam, rabbi, or similar official of any religious organization((, and judges of courts of limited 13 14 jurisdiction as defined in RCW 3.02.010)). That a marriage is 15 solemnized by a duly appointed tribal court judge from a federally recognized tribe pursuant to authority under this section does not 16 create tribal court jurisdiction and does not affect state court 17 18 authority as otherwise provided by law to enter a judgment for purposes of any dissolution, legal separation, or other proceedings 19 20 related to the marriage that is binding on the parties and entitled 21 to full faith and credit."

## HB 1113 - S COMM AMD By Committee on Law & Justice

On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "marriages" strike the remainder of the title and insert "by judges of tribal courts from a federally recognized tribe; and amending RCW 26.04.050."

<u>EFFECT:</u> Specifies that tribal court judges from a federally recognized tribe may solemnize marriages.
