1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 77.32.480 and 2013 c 101 s 1 are each amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 (1) Upon written application, a combination fishing license shall  
6 be issued at the reduced rate of five dollars and all hunting  
7 licenses shall be issued at the reduced rate of a youth hunting  
8 license fee for the following individuals:

9 (a) A resident sixty-five years old or older who is an honorably  
10 discharged veteran of the United States armed forces having a  
11 service-connected disability;

12 (b) A resident who is an honorably discharged veteran of the  
13 United States armed forces with a thirty percent or more service-  
14 connected disability;

15 (c) A resident with a disability who permanently uses a  
16 wheelchair;

17 (d) A resident who is blind or visually impaired; and

18 (e) A resident with a developmental disability as defined in RCW  
19 71A.10.020 with documentation of the disability certified by a  
20 physician licensed to practice in this state.

21 (2) Upon department verification of eligibility, a nonstate  
22 resident veteran with a disability who otherwise satisfies the  
23 criteria of subsection (1)(a) and (b) of this section must be issued  
24 a combination fishing license or any hunting license at the same cost  
25 charged to a nondisabled Washington resident for the same license.

26 (3) Upon written application and department verification, the  
27 following recreational hunting licenses must be issued at no cost to  
28 a resident member of the state guard or national guard, as defined in  
29 RCW 38.04.010, as long as the state guard or national guard member  
30 is: An active full-time state guard or national guard employee; or a  
31 state guard or national guard member whose status requires the state

1 guard or national guard member to participate in drill training on a  
2 part-time basis:

3 (a) A small game hunting license under RCW 77.32.460(1);

4 (b) A supplemental migratory bird permit under RCW 77.32.350; and

5 (c) A big game hunting license under RCW 77.32.450 (1) and (2)."

6 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "77 RCW;" strike the  
7 remainder of the title and insert "and amending RCW 77.32.480."

EFFECT: Removes contingent effective date language. Provides eligibility to a state or national guard member who participates in drill training on a part-time basis.
