1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.24
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) There is a wine retailer reseller endorsement to a beer
6 and/or wine specialty shop license issued under RCW 66.24.371, to
7 sell wine at retail in original containers to retailers licensed to
8 sell wine for consumption on the premises, for resale at their
9 licensed premises according to the terms of the license. However, no
10 single sale may exceed twenty-four liters, unless the sale is made by
11 a licensee that was a former state liquor store or contract liquor
12 store at the location from which such sales are made. For the
13 purposes of this title, a beer and/or wine specialty shop license is
14 a retail license, and a sale by a beer and/or wine specialty shop
15 license with a reseller endorsement is a retail sale only if not for
16 resale. The annual fee for the wine retailer reseller endorsement is
17 one hundred ten dollars for each store.

18 (2) A beer and/or wine specialty shop licensee with a wine
19 retailer reseller endorsement issued under this section may accept
20 delivery of wine at its licensed premises or at one or more warehouse
21 facilities registered with the board, which facilities may also
22 warehouse and distribute nonliquor items, and from which it may
23 deliver to its own licensed premises and, pursuant to sales permitted
24 by this title, to other licensed premises, to other registered
25 facilities, or to lawful purchasers outside the state. Facilities may
26 be registered and utilized by associations, cooperatives, or
27 comparable groups of beer and/or wine specialty shop licensees.

28 **Sec. 2.** RCW 66.28.340 and 2012 c 2 s 123 are each amended to
29 read as follows:

30 (1) A retailer authorized to sell wine may accept delivery of
31 wine at its licensed premises or at one or more warehouse facilities

1 registered with the board, which facilities may also warehouse and
2 distribute nonliquor items, and from which it may deliver to its own
3 licensed premises and, pursuant to sales permitted by this title, to
4 other licensed retailers, to other registered facilities, or to
5 lawful purchasers outside the state; such facilities may be
6 registered and utilized by associations, cooperatives, or comparable
7 groups of retailers including at least one retailer licensed to sell
8 wine. A restaurant retailer authorized to sell spirits may accept
9 delivery of spirits at its licensed premises or at one or more
10 warehouse facilities registered with the board, which facilities may
11 also warehouse and distribute nonliquor items, from which it may
12 deliver to its own licensed premises and, pursuant to sales permitted
13 by this title, to other licensed retailers, to other registered
14 facilities, or to lawful purchasers outside the state; such
15 facilities may be registered and utilized by associations,
16 cooperatives, or comparable groups of retailers including at least
17 one restaurant retailer licensed to sell spirits. Nothing in this
18 section authorizes sales of spirits or wine by a retailer holding
19 only an on-sale privilege to another retailer.

20 (2) A retailer authorized to sell both wine and spirits for
21 consumption off the licensed premises may accept delivery of wine and
22 spirits at its licensed premises, at another licensed premises as
23 designated by the retailer, or at one or more warehouse facilities
24 registered with the board, which facilities may also warehouse and
25 distribute nonliquor items, and from which it may deliver to its own
26 licensed premises and, pursuant to sales permitted by this title, to
27 other licensed retailers, to other registered facilities, or to
28 lawful purchasers outside the state. Such warehouse facilities may be
29 registered and utilized by associations, cooperatives, or comparable
30 groups of retailers including at least one retailer licensed to sell
31 both spirits and wine. For purposes of negotiating volume discounts,
32 a group of individual retailers authorized to sell both wine and
33 spirits for consumption off the licensed premises may accept delivery
34 of wine and spirits at a single location, which may be their
35 individual licensed premises or at any one of the individual
36 licensee's premises, or at a warehouse facility registered with the
37 board."

1 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "state;" strike the
2 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 66.28.340; and adding
3 a new section to chapter 66.24 RCW."

EFFECT: A group of individual retailers who use collective buying to achieve volume discounts may only accept delivery of the order at a single location.
