1 On page 186, after line 39, insert the following:

2 "(10) Within the amounts appropriated in section, the student
3 achievement council is directed to disburse state need grants amounts
4 to institutions of higher education, which shall include awards for
5 students enrolled in three to five credit-bearing quarter credits, or
6 the equivalent semester credits."

8 On page 234, line 38, after "Sec. 926", insert

9 "RCW 28B.92.080 and 2012 c 229 s 605 are each amended to read as
10 follows:

11 Except for opportunity internship graduates whose eligibility
12 is provided under RCW 28B.92.084, for a student to be eligible for a
13 state need grant a student must:

14 (1) Be a "needy student" or "disadvantaged student" as
15 determined by the office in accordance with RCW 28B.92.030

16 ~~((+1))~~(2) and ~~((+4))~~(5);

17 (2) Have been domiciled within the state of Washington for at
18 least one year;

19 (3) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment ~~((on at least a half-~~
20 ~~time basis))~~for at least three quarter credits or the equivalent
21 semester credits at an institution of higher education in Washington
22 as defined in RCW 28B.92.030~~((+3))~~(4); and

23 (4) ~~((Until June 30, 2011, to the extent funds are specifically~~
24 ~~appropriated for this purpose, and subject to any terms and~~
25 ~~conditions specified in the omnibus appropriations act, be enrolled~~
26 ~~or accepted for enrollment for at least three quarter credits or the~~

1 ~~equivalent semester credits at an institution of higher education in~~
2 ~~Washington as defined in RCW 28B.92.030(3); and~~
3 (5)) Have complied with all the rules adopted by the council
4 for the administration of this chapter."

5 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
6 internal references accordingly.

7 EFFECT: Students who are enrolled or accepted for enrollment for
at least three quarter credits, or the equivalent semester hours, in
a qualifying higher education program are eligible for SNG. The
expired pilot program allowing less-than-half-time students to be
eligible for the SNG program is removed from statute.
