1 On page 125, on line 35, after "prevention." Insert the following:

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3 "Of the amounts provided in this section \$26,000 of the general
4 fund-state appropriation for fiscal year 2017 is provided solely for
5 the office of the superintendent of public instruction to develop a
6 statewide anti-bullying training for school district staff that act as
7 the primary contact for the school district's anti-harassment,
8 intimidation, or bullying policy, as required by RCW 28A.300.285. The
9 training shall include materials addressing harassment, intimidation,
10 or bullying as defined in 28A.300.285; transgender student policy and
11 procedures created by the Washington state school directors'
12 association; and materials addressing hazing. The office of
13 superintendent of public instruction to work in collaboration with the
14 educational service districts to offer the statewide anti-bullying
15 training at least once at each of the educational service districts.
16 The office of the superintendent of public instruction shall align the
17 questions in the healthy youth survey with the model transgender
18 student policy and procedure created by the Washington state school
19 directors' association."

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EFFECT: Requires the office of the superintendent of public
instruction (OSPI) to develop and provide training for school
district staff that act as the point of contact for the anti-
harassment, intimidation, or bullying policy. The training must be
held once at each of the educational service districts. OSPI must
align the healthy youth survey questions with the model transgender
policy and procedure created by the Washington state school
directors' association.
