Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium, making various modifications to agency appropriations.

**Summary of Bill (Proposed Substitute)**: Appropriations are made for state transportation agencies and programs for the 2015-17 fiscal biennium. Additionally, the 2013-15 biennial appropriations for various transportation agencies and programs are modified.
