1 AN ACT Relating to delaying annual leave payments upon employment 2 termination due to a reduction in force; and amending RCW 43.01.041.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.01.041 and 2011 1st sp.s. c 39 s 13 are each 5 amended to read as follows:

6 Officers and employees referred to in RCW 43.01.040 whose 7 employment is terminated by their death, reduction in force, resignation, dismissal, or retirement, and who have accrued vacation 8 leave as specified in RCW 43.01.040 or 43.01.044, shall be paid 9 ((therefor)) under their contract of employment, or their estate if 10 11 they are deceased, or if the employee in case of voluntary 12 resignation has provided adequate notice of termination. Officers and employees who resign, are dismissed, or who leave employment because 13 14 of a reduction in force may request that payment of earned vacation leave be delayed for a period of up to one hundred eighty calendar 15 16 days. Annual leave accumulated under RCW 43.01.044 is not to be 17 included in the computation of retirement benefits. From July 1, 2011, through June 29, 2013, the amount of pay received by 18 an employee under the provisions of this section shall not be reduced by 19 20 any temporary salary reduction.

1 Should the legislature revoke any benefits or rights provided 2 under chapter 292, Laws of 1985, no affected officer or employee 3 shall be entitled thereafter to receive such benefits or exercise 4 such rights as a matter of contractual right.

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
